2. Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates as per Government of India Rules, **in respect of the posts reserved for those categories.**
3. Age concession to the extent of service rendered in other research projects in ICMR will also be admissible for experience and skilled persons.
4. In the online application all the fields should be filled. No field should be left blank. Write Not applicable" if any field does not apply to your position

5. Clear proof of Qualifications, Experience, Caste / Community should be attached. Applications without these required attachments shall be rejected.
6. Candidates should avoid to upload pictures taken with mobile phone cameras.
7. Incomplete application or Application without supportive evidence asked for, shall be summarily rejected.
8. Date / time of personal interview / Skype interview will be intimated through email for Eligible/ Shortlisted candidates only.
9. Candidate should submit all copies of certificates / testimonials on Online.
10. Experience certificate should clearly state the nature of work during the period of employment.
11. Community/ Caste certificate: Candidates applying under OBC category, shall submit attested copy of OBC Non – Creamy Layer Certificate in specified format, issued within one year from the closing date of application by the appropriate authority. Only Non Creamy Layer OBC certificates will be accepted and other certificates will not be accepted.
12. No- Objection Certificate from the current employer (for Govt./AB/PSU Servants only).
